Know ye, That Daniel Zimmer a
Private of Captain Jacob E. Gauen's
Company, (H.) 49 Regiment of Illinois Infantry
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Sixteenth day of September
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty One to serve Three years or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
this Fifteenth day of January, 1864, at Memphis
Tennessee by reason of having re-enlisted as a Veteran Volunteer
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.) Series 1863

Said Private Daniel Zimmer was born in Beiern
in the State of Germany, is twenty three years of age,
five feet Six inches high, Dark complexion, Brown eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

GIVEN at Memphis Tennessee this Fifteenth day of
January 1864.
